The Smart Kids Generation began as a Saturday kids club for kids ages 4 and 10. Later in 2022, The Smart Kids Generation became an afterschool program for kids ages 4 to 12 located at P.L. Brion school. Later during the summer vacation, we moved to a new location at Emmy Berthold school.

The Smart Kids Generation has a total of 45 kids from different backgrounds. Most of them have behavioral problems or social-economic problems. We offer them homework guidance, food, and activities from 12:30 to 18:00.

Another project Adventure Kids Curacao Foundation has is a collaboration with a local school in Bonaire, where innovative teaching and learner engagement methods are accumulated to be

disseminated among schools on the island. This helps the schools a lot by reducing printing costs for books that the children need, however, their families are not able to provide for them. This project started with Math books shared with 5 public schools in Curacao.

This project is still going on having helped around 600 children altogether.

2.2 Activities:

2.2.1 – Erasmus + Projects:



Erasmus+ is the EU's program to support education, training, youth, and sport in Europe.

We will start working on this project to create opportunities for our youth workers, leaders, kids, and parents to learn and gain knowledge in different aspects of their lives and profession.

2.2.3 – Digitalization for the afterschool:

This project will give the kids the boost they need in their digital skills. The goal is to make the children aware of how to deal with the possibilities of media and technology: Microsoft Word or Google Docs, Microsoft Excel or Google sheets, Microsoft PowerPoint or Google Slides, and Social Media(s).



3 - Our organization...

Adventure Kids Curacao Foundation (AKCFoundation) is a Curacao-based organization with the main focus to provide activities that stimulate cognitive, expressive, and, sportive skills for immigrant children to prevent them from getting engaged in criminal activities.

The activities are for disadvantaged children or immigrant children (from Venezuela, Colombia, Jamaica, and the Dominican Republic) and they take shape of extracurricular activities for training skills useful for integration into the local community (summer camp, hobby classes, systematic educational events).

3.1 – Management Board:

The management board of Adventure Kids Curacao Foundation (K.v.K 145459 in Curacao) did not change during 2022. The Board consists of 3 unpaid board members. The board members don't have to be re-elected at the end of the period. They can submit a letter of resignation when they want to resign and we will start the process of looking for a trustworthy board member to replace the one who is leaving.

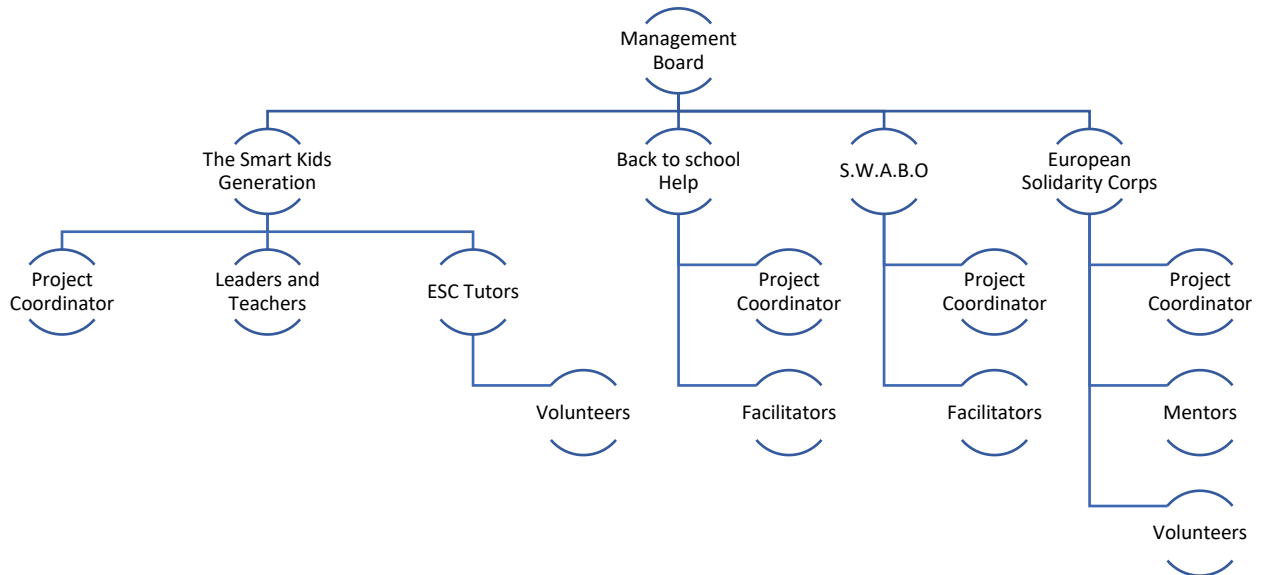
3.2 – Collaborators:
